SECTION III: Adoption of the Uniform Traffic Code and Control of Traffic in Parking Areas

- MCL 257.951 – MCL 257.954
- MCL 357.941 – MCL 257.943

SECTION IV: Adoption of the Michigan Liquor Control Code and Parts 811 and 821 of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act

- MCL 324.81101 – MCL 324.81150
- MCL 324.82101 – MCL 324.82160
- MCL 436.1101 – MCL 436.2303

SECTION V --- EFFECTIVE DATE: Provides for Ordinance to take effect 30 days after publication as required by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-06-06

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT CERTAIN STATE STATUTES AS TOWNSHIP ORDINANCES PURSUANT TO STATE LAW AND TO ADOPT THE PENALTIES PRESCRIBED BY STATE LAW.

THETFORD TOWNSHIP ORDAINS:

SECTION 1 - Adoption of the Michigan Vehicle Code by reference

1. The Michigan vehicle code, MCL 257.1 to 257.923 is adopted by reference as Township Ordinance for all civil infractions and misdemeanors where the maximum penalty proscribed is imprisonment for 93 days or less and the same penalties as proscribed under State law are adopted.
2. Section 625(1)(c) of the Michigan vehicle code, MCL 257.625 is adopted by reference as Township Ordinance and the a violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor punishable by one or more of the following:
 - a. Community service for not more than 360 hours.
 - b. Imprisonment for not more than 180 days.
 - c. A fine of not less than \$200.00 or more than \$700.00.

SECTION 2 - Adoption of the Motor Carrier Act, Motor Carrier Safety Act, and Motor Carrier Fuel Tax Act

1. The Motor Carrier Act, MCL 475.1 – MCL 479.43, is adopted by reference as Township Ordinance for all civil infractions and misdemeanors where the maximum penalty proscribed is imprisonment for 93 days or less and the same penalties as proscribed under State law are adopted.
2. The Motor Carrier Safety Act, MCL 480.11 – MCL 480.25, is adopted by reference as Township Ordinance for all civil infractions and misdemeanors where the maximum penalty proscribed is imprisonment for 93 days or less and the same penalties as proscribed under State law are adopted.
3. The Motor Carrier Fuel Tax Act, MCL 207.211 – MCL 207.232, is adopted by reference as Township Ordinance for all civil infractions and misdemeanors where the maximum penalty proscribed is imprisonment for 93 days or less and the same penalties as proscribed under State law are adopted.

SECTION 3 - Adoption of the Uniform Traffic Code and Control of Traffic in Parking Areas

1. The Uniform Traffic Code, MCL 257.951 – MCL 257.954, is adopted by reference as Township Ordinance and the same penalties as proscribed under State law for all civil infractions are adopted. The Township Clerk shall maintain in his or her office a copy of the code for inspection as required by MCL 257.954.
2. The Control of Traffic in Parking Areas, MCL 357.941 – MCL 257.943, is adopted by reference as Township Ordinance and the same penalties as proscribed under State law for all civil infractions are adopted.

SECTION 4 - Adoption of the Michigan Liquor Control Code and Parts 811 and 821 of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act

1. Part 811 of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, MCL 324.81101 – MCL 324.81150, pertaining to off-road recreational vehicles, is adopted by reference as Township Ordinance for all civil infractions and misdemeanors where the maximum penalty proscribed is imprisonment for 93 days or less and the same penalties as proscribed under State law are adopted.
2. Part 821 of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, MCL 324.82101 – MCL 324.82160, pertaining to snowmobiles, is adopted by reference as Township Ordinance for all civil infractions and misdemeanors where the maximum penalty proscribed is imprisonment for 93 days or less and the same penalties as proscribed under State law are adopted.
3. The Michigan Liquor Control Code of 1998, MCL 436.1101 – MCL 436.2303 is adopted by reference as Township Ordinance for all civil infractions and misdemeanors where the maximum penalty proscribed is imprisonment for 93 days or less and the same penalties as proscribed under State law are adopted.

SECTION 5 - Invalidity

If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or part of the Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason whatsoever, such a decision shall not affect the remaining portions of the Ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect and the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby declared severable.

SECTION 6 - Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after the first publication of the Ordinance.

SECTION 7 - Publication

This Ordinance shall be published as required by law and as required by MCL 41.184.

SECTION 8 - Where Ordinance can be Inspected

A copy of this Ordinance can be obtained from the Clerk of Thetford Township at the offices of Thetford Township, 4014 East Vienna Road, Clio, Michigan. Copies of the statutes adopted by reference shall be kept in the office of the township clerk, available for inspection by and distribution to the public.


