OPEN BURNING IN THE CLIO AREA FIRE DISTRICT

Here are a few tips that Residents should be aware of before any burning:

Everyone living in the City limits of Clio must get a Burn Permit at the City Offices before burning.

The CLIO AREA FIRE DEPARTMENT requires everyone to call the BURN LINE before you start your FIRE at 810-686-5432.

NO BURN PERMITS NEEDED IN VIENNA OR THETFORD TOWNSHIPS.

- Fallen Trees and brush are the only items that residents are allowed to burn.
- Clear an area around where you are going to burn so the fire does not spread.
- DO NOT burn when it is windy. Wind can blow sparks and start fires a great distance away from the original fire.
- Do not burn if officials have declared a Burn Ban due to dry conditions.
- An adult must attend the fire at all times. Do not leave the fire until it has been totally extinguished and do not allow children to play around the fire.
- Keep a garden hose or a bucket of water available to contain the fire.
- Campfires and open cooking fires are allowed, but must be monitored. Keep to an acceptable size and attended to at all times. Campfires should be in a container designed for that purpose or a fire pit that will contain the fire. BUT, if there is a burn ban, you are NOT PERMITTED TO BURN AT ALL!
- Cooking fires in a gas or charcoal grill and campfires in a metal container made specifically for this
 purpose as long as they are small, does not require you to call the burn line.

UNDER MICHIGAN LAW, RESIDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BURN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

LEAVES OR GRASS CLIPPINGS

BUILDINGS

CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION WASTE

RUBBISH OR TRASH

FURNITURE

PLASTICS/RUBBER

TIRES

COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL WASTE
