## Activities at Thetford Senior Center April 2024

<u>BALANCE & TONE</u>: (Fridays at 9 am) Join our fabulous instructor Darci as she works with you to help improve your balance, gently stretch your upper body, and gain back your confidence. Spend part of the class standing and part using a chair; work at your own pace. FREE

## Mi Cafe

If you are in need of food assistance our MMAP counselor Cindi Groulx may be able to assist you. For everyone 60 and up or disabled, the maximum monthly allowable income to apply for a Bridge Card is \$2266 for a household of one and \$3052

for a household of two. Medical, shelter, and phone expenses are then deducted. Proof of income will need to be provided. A Bridge Card will be issued if the monthly readulat income is

11870(1) or 2520(2) or less. At 1870/2520 the cards value will only be 23. The lower the residual income the higher the food benefit. The maximum monthly benefit is 281 for
