Recipe of the Month

Serving on March 22nd

Mom's Lasagna

1 lb. ground beef
2 garlic cloves, minced
1 1/2 c. water
15 oz. can tomato sauce
6 oz. can tomato paste
4 c. shredded mozzarella
1/2 to 1 envelope onion soup

1 tsp. dried oregano 1/2 tsp. sugar 1/4 tsp. pepper 9 lasagna noodles, cooked 2 c. small curd cottage cheese 2 c. grated parmesan cheese

In a large saucepan, cook beef and garlic over medium heat until meat is no longer pink; drain. Stir in water, tomato sauce and paste, soup mix, oregano, sugar and pepper. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat and cover; simmer for 30 minutes. Spoon 1/2 cup meat sauce into a greased 9"x13" baking dish. Layer with three noodles and a third of the cottage cheese, mozzarella cheese, meat sauce and parmesan cheese. Repeat layers twice. Cover and bake at 350 degrees for 40 minutes or until bubbly and heated through. Uncover; bake 5 to 10 minutes longer. Let stand for 10 minutes before cutting.

If you are in need of food assistance our MMAP counselor Cindi Groulx may be able to assist you. For everyone 60 and up or disabled, the maximum monthly allowable income to apply for a Bridge Card is \$2266 for a household of one and \$3052 for a household of two. Medical, shelter, and phone expenses are then deducted. Proof of income will need to be provided. A Bridge Card will be issued if the monthly residual income is \$1870 (1) or \$2520 (2) or less.

At \$1870/\$2520 the cards value will only be \$23. The lower the residual income the higher the food benefit. The maximum monthly benefit is \$281 for 1 person and \$516 for 2 people.
